Enough With The Noise!



Remember the problems in Quebec last season that led to the closure of a popular section of trail? Modifying your exhaust system can close trails. Help preserve our land access. It's illegal to modify your snowmobile's stock exhaust system. Disturbing landowner's and nearby residents can result in trail closure!

Did you know?

- > A jet engine produces 140 dB.
- > A shotgun firing produces 130 dB.
- > A Jackhammer produces 110 dB
- > A snowmobile with stock exhaust is legally restricted to 78 dB exterior and 73 dB operator. Modified exhausts can easily exceed 100 dB making that 2-stroke rumble as annoying as a jackhammer to those nearby.

Regular exposure to 100dB exceeding 1 minute can cause permanent hearing loss.
